MSC – Frequently asked questions

The questions below are representative of the most common inquiries or comments that we are hearing from industry. We have provided answers to specific questions and described other things we have done in response to industry inquiries.

Q1: How can I identify current MSC procurement opportunities?

A: You can identify current procurement opportunities in your product or service area by checking Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) (<https://www.fbo.gov>) or by checking the **CONTRACTS** tab on our MSC website and opening one of the two links, listed under **BUSINESS OPPORTUNITES**. FBO can also assist you in identifying other DoD, as well as other Federal procurement opportunities.

Q2: As a new small business, interested in doing business with MSC and the NAVY, how do I get started, and register in the specific systems, to be able to conduct business with the Federal government?

A: Under the SMALL BUSINESS PROGRAM section on our MSC website, we have a section entitled “Doing Business with MSC”. The section contains general information and links on how to register in the required systems and how to locate opportunities.

Q3: How do I locate responsible small businesses, in a specific geographical area for subcontracting work?

A: The SBA Dynamic Small Business Search Engine is a great tool to locate small businesses within a specific geographical area. The SBA Dynamic Small Business Search Engine will also provide socio-economic categories.
