Subj: CIVILIAN MARINER (CIVMAR) PAY FREEZE

Ref: (a) Email A. Schaffer DoD/CMPS/K. Rascher (N13) COMSC of 28 Dec 10

1. Section 147 of the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Pub. L. 111-242), as amended by section 1(a) of the Continuing Appropriations and Surface Transportation Extensions Act, 2011 (Pub. L. 111-322, December 22, 2010) froze General Schedule (GS) employees' pay for two years.
2. My staff requested clarification from DoD Civilian Personnel Management System, Wage Setting Division, as to whether or not MSC's CIVMAR wage schedules were included in this legislation. DoD responded in reference (a) confirming that MSC's CIVMAR pay was included. Therefore, CIVMAR wage schedules will remain at their current level for the next two years.
