**ATLANTIC AND PACIFIC SCHEDULE OF WAGES
RADIO AND RADIO ELECTRONICS OFFICERS**

EFFECTIVE DATE: 01 July 2010

1. The base pay of all Radio Officers includes an additional amount for radiotelephone operation during regular watch hours and an additional amount in lieu of any overtime for servicing the radiotelephone, including repairs and batteries.
2. Radio Officers holding an FCC Radar Endorsement are required to make weekly inspections of operational conditions of the radar equipment, perform preventative maintenance procedures, maintain inventory of spare parts, and requisition spare parts as necessary.
3. The monthly nonwatchstanding allowance is to be added to the applicable base pay in computing leave, bonuses, and hazardous cargo pay only. Nonwatchstanding allowance is to be added to base pay in computing the amount of pay when compensatory time off is taken. Nonwatchstanding allowance is not to be considered as part of Base Pay for retirement calculations.
4. Monthly Supplement Rate (payable only when assigned to a ship):
 - Pay Schedule Lines 900 through 985: **\$175.20** per month
 - Pay Schedule Lines 1020 through 1105: **\$188.16** per month
