

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

USCG Approved Courses and Programs

BASIC FF - BASIC FIRE FIGHTING (3 Days)

- ✓ Part of STCW Basic Safety Training (BST) – **USCG Approved**
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training
- ✓ USCG requirement changing to every 5 years in 2017 (Refresher)
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.

Any student who successfully completes the 25-hour Basic Fire Fighting course will satisfy: (1) a) the Basic Safety Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-2 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 10.205(l)(2); --AND-- (2) the Basic Fire Fighting training requirements of 46 CFR 10.205(g) and 10.401(g)(1) for a license; --AND-- (3) the Fire Fighting training requirements of 46 CFR 13.113(d)(2)(i)(A), 13.113(e)(1)(i)(A) or (B), 13.201(e), 13.301(e),

MSC BASIC FF

PSSR - PERSONAL SAFETY & SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES (1 Day)

- ✓ Part of STCW Basic Safety Training (BST) – **USCG Approved**
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training
- ✓ USCG requirement changing to every 5 years in 2017 (Refresher)
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.

PSSR

Any student who successfully completes the 7-hour Personal Safety & Social Responsibilities course will satisfy the Personal Safety & Social Responsibilities training requirements of 46 CFR 10.205(l)(4) and Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-4 of the STCW Code.

PERSONAL SURVIVAL TECHNIQUES (1.5 Days)

- ✓ Part of STCW Basic Safety Training (BST) – **USCG Approved**
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training
- ✓ USCG requirement changing to every 5 years in 2017 (Refresher)
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.

PER SURVIVAL

Any student who has successfully completed the 12-hour Personal Survival Techniques course will satisfy the Personal Survival Techniques training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-1 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 10.205(l)(1).

FIRST AID & CPR (1 Day)

FIRST AID

- ✓ Part of STCW Basic Safety Training (BST) – **USCG Approved**
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training
- ✓ USCG requirement changing to every 5 years in 2017 (Refresher)
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.

Any student who has successfully completed the 8-hour First Aid & CPR course will satisfy the Basic Safety - Elementary First Aid training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-3 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 10.205(l)(3); AND if presented WITHIN ONE YEAR of the date of training, the First Aid & CPR training requirements of 46 CFR 10.205(h)(1)(ii) and 10.205(h)(2)(iii) for original issuance of a license.

ADV FF - ADVANCED FIRE FIGHTING (3 Days, but must be combined with Basic)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Will be 4 day stand alone course - TBD

MSC ADV FF

Any student who successfully completes the 25-hour Advanced Fire Fighting course will satisfy the Advanced Fire Fighting training requirements of Section A-VI/3 and Table A-VI/3 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 10.205(l)(2); and the Advanced Fire Fighting training requirements of 46 CFR 10.205(g) and 10.401(g)(1) for a license. 13.401(d) or 13.501(e) for any tankerman endorsement.

LIFEBOAT - PROFICIENCY IN SURVIVAL CRAFT (5 Days)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Not on the schedule, but scheduled upon request for MSC CIVMARS

Any student who successfully completes the 35-hour Survival Craft course will satisfy the Survival Craft training requirements of Section A-VI/2 and Table A-VI/2-1 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 12.10-3(a)(6) for any endorsement as Lifeboatman, provided that sea service requirements are also met; AND if presented WITHIN ONE YEAR of the completion of training, the written and practical examination requirements of 46 CFR 12.10-5 for a Lifeboatman endorsement (exam module 481xx) and the written "Survival Craft" examination requirements for service on vessels not equipped with lifeboats (exam module 441xx or 706xx).

AB - ABLE SEAMAN (7 Days)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Not on the schedule, but scheduled upon request for MSC CIVMARS

Any student who successfully completes the 48-hour Able Seaman course will satisfy the written examination requirements of 46 CFR 12.05-9 for the "Deck & Navigation General / Deck Safety" and "Deck General & Safety / Rules of the Road" exam modules for any Able Seaman endorsement if presented WITHIN ONE YEAR of the completion of training; --AND-- the training and assessment requirements for issuance of an STCW certification as Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch RESTRICTED to lookout duties only. This certification is valid for one year and may not be renewed.

FRB - FAST RESCUE BOAT (5 Days)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Not on the schedule, but scheduled upon request for MSC CIVMARS

Any student who successfully completes the 30-hour Fast Rescue Boat course will satisfy the requirements of Table A-VI/2-2 of the STCW Code, Specification of the Minimum Standard of Competence in Fast Rescue Boats.

RFPNW - RATING FORMING PART OF A NAVIGATIONAL WATCH (Program)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Only for MSC CIVMARS
- ✓ Not on schedule

Any CIVMAR who successfully completes the Rating Forming part of a Navigational Watch Program will satisfy the training and assessment requirements of 46 CFR 12.05-3(c) and Section A-II/4 and Table A-II/4 of the STCW Code, Specification of Minimum Standard of Competence for Ratings Forming Part of a Navigational Watch. Applicants who present a certificate of training from this Program need not present evidence of service or assessments; the certificate alone is sufficient.

RFPNW - RATING FORMING PART OF A NAVIGATIONAL WATCH (1 Day) (LOOKOUT DUTIES ONLY)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.

MSC RFPIW

Any student who successfully completes the 8-hour Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch (Lookout Duties Only) course will satisfy the training requirements for certification as Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch RESTRICTED to lookout duties only. This certification will be valid for one year and may not be renewed. NOTE: Training certificate will describe this the RFPNW ***COURSE***

RFPEW - RATING FORMING PART OF AN ENGINEERING WATCH (Program)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Only for MSC CIVMARS
- ✓ Not on schedule

Any CIVMAR who successfully completes the Rating Forming Part of an Engineering Watch Program will satisfy the service, training and assessment requirements of 46 CFR 12.15-3(d), 46 CFR 12.15-7(c), and Section A-III/4 and Table A-III/4 of the STCW code, Specification of Minimum Standard of Competence for Ratings Forming Part of an Engine Watch For Motor and/or Steam Propulsion. The specific propulsion mode(s) the applicant qualifies for will be noted on the certificate of training.

IMMERSION SUIT TRAINING (2 Hours)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Not on the schedule, but scheduled upon request

Any student completing the 2-hour Immersion Suit Training course will satisfy the Personal Survival Techniques training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-1 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 10.205(I)(1) PROVIDED that they have also completed U.S. Navy Recruit Training AND have acquired at least one year of sea service every five years since the completion of the recruit training.

BST – BASIC SAFETY TRAINING (5 DAYS)

- ✓ **Pending USCG Approval**
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Will be going to 5 day BST course starting date TBD, this course will meet the requirements of STCW
- ✓ This replaces the individual course of PSSR, Personal Survival, First Aid & Basic FF

Any student who successfully completes the 5 day BST course will satisfy:

- Basic Safety Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-2 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR
- Elementary First Aid training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-3 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR
- Personal Safety & Social Responsibilities training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-4 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR
- Personal Survival Techniques training requirements of Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-1 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR

USCG APPROVED BASIC SAFETY TRAINING (BST)

DE – DESIGNATED EXEMAINER (1 Day)

- ✓ **USCG Approved**
- ✓ Not on the schedule, but scheduled upon request

This course is for the MSC TOAR program. Candidates must have 2 years sea time as Tug Master to be qualified as DE.

MSC/MSFSC Readiness Courses

ASO – AFLOAT SAFETY OFFICER (2 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Class is taught in Virginia by Safety Department

AFLOAT SAFETY OFFICER (VA)

Any student who successfully completes the ASO course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is for First Officers, MSO, and anyone aboard assigned as Ship Safety Officer. This trains the officer to effectively manage a ship's safety program.

CBR-D ORIENTATION (1 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training

MSC CBR-D

Any student who successfully completes the Chemical Biological & Radiological – Defense Orientation course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student must be able to demonstrate the ability to properly don protective clothing and gas mask. Student will also demonstrate proper use of Nerve Agent First aid and have practical knowledge of the DECON process.

CBR-D OFFICER (6 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years

Any student who successfully completes the Chemical Biological & Radiological – Defense Officer course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student must be able to demonstrate the ability to properly don protective clothing and gas mask. Student will also demonstrate proper use of Nerve Agent First aid and the DECON process. The student will understand Chemical Agent detection and DECON. The student will understand the principles of RADCALC and the use of radiation measuring devices.

MSC CBR-D OFFICER MSC CBR-D OFFICER

DAMAGE CONTROL (1 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years as part of refresher training

MSC DC

Any student who successfully completes the Damage Control course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student must be able to demonstrate the ability to do pipe patching, shoring, dewatering, and hull patching during an emergency aboard ship.

HELO FF – SHIPBOARD HELICOPTER FIRE FIGHTING (.5 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Required for Helicopter Deck Fire Party members

Any student who successfully completes the Helo FF course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. Students working as a team learn how to combat various Helicopter Crash and Fire scenarios.

Any student who successfully completes the Marine Environmental course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is a lecture base overview course on MSC's Policies IRT the marine environment including garbage restriction, oil discharges and marine mammals as well as hazardous material.

TIP - TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS & PRIVACY ACT (.5 Day)

- ✓ Generally taught every other week after MEP class.

Any student who successfully completes the TIP & Privacy Act Lecture will satisfy the MSC training requirement.

NAVOSH - NAVY OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH (.5 DAYS)

- ✓ Generally taught every other week after Helicopter Fire Fighting class.

Any student who successfully completes the NAVOSH course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is a lecture base overview course on MSC's Safety Policies not already covered in PSSR and MEP

SERVE SAFE (.5 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Required for food handlers and cooks – SU, all Cooks and Bakers

Any student who successfully completes the Serve Safe course will satisfy the MSC training requirement for safe handling of food.

SERV - SAFE

HV - HIGH VOLTAGE (.5 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Required for T-AKE class

HIGH VOLT

Any student who successfully completes the High Voltage course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is lecture base covers the risks involved with the high voltage system aboard the T-AKE class vessels.

MSC REFRESHER (5 Days)

- ✓ **Pending USCG Approval for BST Refresher – Date TBD**
- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC requires every 5 years
- ✓ USCG BST requirement changing to every 5 years in 2017

Any student who successfully completes the MSC Refresher course will satisfy the MSC training requirements for Basic FF, PSSR, Personal Survival, First Aid, Helo FF, CBR-D Orientation, MEP, TIP/Privacy Act, AT-Level I, and DC.

BST & MSC READINESS REFRESHER

UNREP FAM – UNDERWAY REPLENISHMENT FAMILIARIZATION (2 Days)

- ✓ Scheduled as needed
- ✓ For New Hires
- ✓ Taught at MUTC Facility
- ✓ Not Required training

UNREP - FAMILIARIZATION

Any student who successfully completes the UNREP Familiarization course will satisfy the MSC training requirements. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. Students learn the fundamentals of UNREP and get the opportunity to operate an UNREP rig.

MSC Force Protection / Anti-Terrorism / Small Arms

SMALL ARMS – NEW JERSEY (4 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC required annually

MSC SMALL ARMS @ FIRE SCHOOL (NJ)

This is a weapons qualification course IAW OPNAV 3591. The weapons to be qualified on are the 9 mm Pistol, 12 gauge Riot Shotgun, and M-14 Rifle. The student will also receive familiarization training on the M-79 Grenade Launcher.

SMALL ARMS – VIRGINIA (4 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Class and Range Location can change every quarter, check with us on current location.
- ✓ MSC required annually

MSC SMALL ARMS @ VIRGINIA

This is a weapons qualification course IAW OPNAV 3591. The weapons to be qualified on are the 9 mm Pistol, 12 gauge Riot Shotgun, and M-14 Rifle. The student will also receive familiarization training on the M-79 Grenade Launcher.

SECURITY WATCH BASIC (2 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC requires this once in a career

SECURITY WATCH BASIC

Any student who successfully completes the Security Watch Basic course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student must be able to demonstrate the ability to stand a proper secure watch to include skills such as entry control, bag searches, bomb searches and basic handcuffing.

SECURITY WATCH ADV (1 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC required annually
- ✓ Will be taught same week as Small Arms in VA

VA CLASSES

Any student who successfully completes the Security Watch ADV course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student must be able to demonstrate the ability to properly use the baton, as well as some basic takedown and handcuffing techniques.

SHIP'S REACTION FORCE (SRF) (3 Days)

SHIP'S REACTION FORCE (SRF)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC required every 3 years for members of SRF

Any student who successfully completes the SRF course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. The student will learn the proper techniques of combat movement, and tactics needed to be part of an effective Ship's Reaction Force.

ATO – ANTI-TERRORISM OFFICER LEVEL II (4 Days)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ MSC required every 3 years for Ships ATO

Any student who successfully completes the ATO Level II course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is lecture based. By completing this course the student will meet the requirements set forth in DoD 2000.16 and COMSC Instruction 5530. This trains the officer to effectively manage a ship's Anti-terrorism / force protection program.

MSC ANTI-TERRORISM OFFICER (ATO) LEVEL II

ATO – ANTI-TERRORISM LEVEL I (.5 Day) SECURITY AWARENESS TRAINING (1 day)

MSC OHA

LEVEL 1 ANTI-TERR

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Generally taught every other week after OHA class.
- ✓ MSC required annually

Any student who successfully completes the AT Level I course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. By completing this course the student will meet the requirements set forth in DoD 2000.16 and COMSC Instruction 5530.



FALL PROTECTION TRAINING

FP-AUTHORIZED PERSON / END USER (1 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Required for anyone going aloft over 4 feet.

FP - AP / EU

Any student who successfully completes the fall Protection Authorized Person course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. This course covers fall Protection procedures set forth in ISM. The student will demonstrate their ability to use fall protection equipment including the wearing the full body harness. Other gear include Work Positioning lanyards, Y-Lanyards, Ladder Climbing devices, Self Retracting Lifelines (SRL), Vertical Lifelines and Rope Grabs.

FP - AUTHORIZED RESCUER (1 Day)

- ✓ See monthly schedule for class dates.
- ✓ Required for the Fall Protection program aboard ship.
- ✓ Recommended for Boatswain, Boatswain-Mates, and AB
- ✓ Must Have taken FP-AP at TCE

FP RESCUER

Any student who successfully completes the fall Protection Authorized Person course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. This course covers fall Protection procedures set forth in SMS. The student will demonstrate their ability to rescue anyone aloft using proper techniques and procedures. A Rescue Plan, and Recue Team are required in SMS.

FP-CP/R – FALL PROTECTION COMPETENT PERSON / RESCUER (3 - 5 Days)

- ✓ Not on schedule
- ✓ Current only done by contractor, possibly looking to bring in-house
- ✓ Required for the Fall Protection program aboard ship.
- ✓ Recommended for First Officers, Boatswain, & Boatswain-Mates, as well as RET

Any student who successfully completes the fall Protection Authorized Person course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This course is both lecture based and practical labs/demonstration. This course covers fall Protection procedures set forth in SMS. This is the Fall Protection Supervisor course for aboard ship. The student will learn how to effectively manage a Fall Protection Program including Rescue.

OHA - Ordnance Hazard Awareness (2 Days)

- ✓ Scheduled as needs dictates with MUTC Facility

Any student who successfully completes the OHA course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This class is a requirement for any Ammo ship.

MHE - Mechanical Handling Equipment (5 Days)

- ✓ Taught at MUTC Facility
- ✓ Not on Schedule
- ✓ Scheduled as needs dictates with MUTC Facility

Any student who successfully completes the OHA course will satisfy the MSC training requirement. This class is a requirement for any Ammo ship.

Magazine Sprinkler – Maintenance (2 Days)

- ✓ Not on Schedule, can be taught on request.

This course meets the requirement for Magazine Sprinkler – Maintenance for original Sprinkler system. Currently not for TAKE 11 – TAKE 14
