GENERAL NOTES:

NOTE 1: Figure in (*italics*) is periodicity for refresher training for that specific course. On the average, refresher training for OHE, MHE can be conducted in two – three days. STREAM refresher training can be conducted in two – four day periods. VERTREP Operations course refresher could be done in one day. Properly supervised and documented experience/training during an exercise or operation can be counted as refresher training. MHE personnel will be determined by unit CO’s.
